Immaculée-Conception boarding school is located in the Occitan part of France, at the entrance of the regional natural park of Aubrac. Being a student in Espalion means living in a town of 4.600 inhabitants, a safe place where it's easy to practice activities.

Options offered to students are subject to availability upon arrival. Lessons are at school or in clubs depending on the activity. Registration may be charged to the student for activities outside school and acceptance is at the discretion of the club.

FAQ

How many students per room?

Shared rooms (4-5 students). Rooms are same-sex

Where are the dorms located? Within the premises

Are outings allowed?

On Wednesday afternoons, from 1 pm to 5:30 pm only if students ask permission to the school office before.

What about laundry?

- 7-day boarders: laundry is done every Friday at school (included)
- 5-day boarders: students can do their laundry on the weekend while at their host family

When are meals?

Breakfast: from 7 am to 7:30 am

Lunch: 12:30 pm

Dinner: from 7:15 pm to 8 pm

Are there set times to do homework?

From 5:45 pm to 7:15 pm with the possibility to extend from 8 pm to 9:30 pm

What about school holidays?

- 5-day boarders stay with a host family with full board (included in the program fee)
- 7-day boarders go home during all school holidays. If the student wishes to stay in France during the local holidays, a Holiday pack can be booked and WEP will arrange a stay in a local, French-speaking host family. The student will receive full board and share the family's everyday life.
