Dunkerque Collège Fénélon

Fénélon school is located in northern France, very close to the seaside and near the Belgian border. It's a 15-minute walk to the city center of Dunkerque or to the beach.

- ▶ **School grades:** 6 to 9 (Collège)
- ▶ **Number of students:** 420 students
- ▶ **Percentage of international students:** 0,4%
- ▶ **Brevet des collèges success rate:** 98,2%
- ▶ **French as a foreign language course:** Not offered at school. The local coordinator can give students information on where to take a French course for an extra fee.
- ▶ **Durations:** academic year (from September), semester (from September or January), term (from September or January), short term - 4 to 8 weeks (from September, November, January or March)
- ▶ **School uniform:** No
- ▶ **Religion classes:** Catholic (optional)

Why do students choose this school?

The school is very well located. It offers about 16 different clubs to practice extra activities.

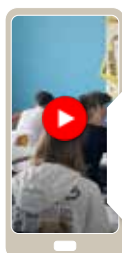
