Orchies Lycée La Providence

The Providence school is located in the north of France, close to the city of Lille and the border with Belgium. Founded in 1836, the school today includes general education as well as vocational studies.

- ▶ **School grades:** 10 to 12 (Lycée)
- ▶ **Number of students:** 600 students
- ▶ **Percentage of international students:** 0,8%
- ▶ **Baccalaureat success rate:** 100%
- ▶ **French as a foreign language course:** Not offered at school. The local coordinator can give students information on where to take a French course for an extra fee.
- ▶ **Duration:** academic year (from September), semester (from September and January), term (from September and January)
- ▶ **School uniform:** Only for vocational studies
- ▶ **Religion classes:** Catholic (optional)

Why do students choose this school?

Students will appreciate the modernity of the classrooms and the options offered by the school.

Good to know

Apart from the general studies, the school also accepts international students for their vocational classes.

Languages taught at school

1st foreign language: English; 2nd foreign language: German or Spanish.
